VISA REQUIREMENTS	A valid passport with visa is mandatory. In view of the bilateral agreements, nationals of the following countries may visit Rwanda without visa for a period up to 90 days: USA, UK, Germany, Canada, Uganda, Tanzania, Kenya, Burundi, Democratic Republic of Congo, Sweden, Mauritius, South Africa and Hong Kong. Visas can be applied for online or bought upon arrival.
DRIVING LICENCE REQUIREMENTS	International Driving Permit is required.
GENERAL RULE OF THE ROAD	Traffic drives on the right.
GENERAL ROAD CONDITIONS	Rwanda has possibly the best roads in East Africa. Some local roads are not paved and a 4-wheel drive vehicle is needed. There can be landslides on some of the major roads during annual rainfall in spring and autumn.
DOCUMENTATION FOR ENTRY OF FOREIGN REGISTERED VEHICLE	For one to drive a vehicle with a foreign registered number plate in Rwanda, they should not be a Rwandan national. A visitor is given 14 days' stay and thereafter has to seek an extension from customs up to a period of three months.
FUEL	Unleaded petrol available.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS	A certificate of yellow-fever vaccination is required. Much of Rwanda lies at too high an elevation for malaria to be a major concern, but the disease is present and prophylactic drugs are strongly recommended. It is advisable not to drink tap water. Bottled mineral water can be bought in all towns. Hospitals are located in all major towns.
