VISA REQUIREMENTS	Tanzania permits visa free travel for a period of up to three months to some foreign nationals, mainly those from African and Asian countries however in most cases, with the exceptions of Kenya and Uganda, these visitors will still need to obtain entry permit clearance.
DRIVING LICENCE REQUIREMENTS	Visitors to Tanzania staying for six months or less are allowed to use a valid foreign driver's license after validation by local traffic authorities, or an international driver's license. Persons intending to remain in Tanzania for more than six months are required to obtain a Tanzanian driver's license.
GENERAL RULE OF THE ROAD	Traffic moves on the left side of the road. Unless otherwise posted, the speed limit is 80km/h; on some routes, including Dar es Salaam to Arusha. There is a seat-belt law for drivers and front-seat passengers.
GENERAL ROAD CONDITIONS	All the major towns in Tanzania are connected by tarmac all weather roads. But outside this network, quality deteriorates. <i>total: 78,891 km paved: 6,808 km unpaved: 72,083 km</i>
DOCUMENTATION FOR ENTRY OF FOREIGN REGISTERED VEHICLE	All vehicles are required to carry third-party liability insurance. Automobiles are admitted into Tanzania for 14 days, with extensions of 14 days up to a total of three months. We strongly recommend the traveler obtain a valid carnet.
FUEL	Unleaded Petrol and Diesel available.
