<b>VISA REQUIREMENTS</b>	Kenyan nationals will require the passport or temporary travel document.
<b>DRIVING LICENCE REQUIREMENTS</b>	Kenya driving licence is recognized for 90 days. An international driving permit is allowed for one year but must be accompanied by the local Kenya driving licence.
<b>GENERAL RULE OF THE ROAD</b>	General rule of the road is keep left.
<b>GENERAL ROAD CONDITIONS</b>	The roads are fair and most parts are tarmac and gravel.
<b>DOCUMENTATION FOR ENTRY OF FOREIGN REGISTERED VEHICLE</b>	Commercial vehicles must have reflectors. Temporary importation papers required and obtainable from the Uganda Revenue Authority. Required to have at least a 3 <sup>rd</sup> party insurance. Comprehensive and 3 <sup>rd</sup> party insurance obtainable at insurance companies in Uganda. Road licences/permits 7 days free and USD 20 beyond 7 days of stay but not more than 30 days. Road toll fees are not required.
<b>FUEL</b>	Unleaded Petrol and Diesel available.
<b>ACCOMODATION</b>	Accommodations can be obtained through these lines +256-782-700013 ,+256-772-415541, and +256-711-700013,+256-702-020777we have safe water
<b>HEALTH REQUIREMENTS</b>	There is safe drinking water but bottled water recommended. A guide on health centers is provided at the place of accommodation.
