<b>GENERAL RULE OF THE ROAD</b>	Keep left. Speed of 110km/hr on the highway and 50km/hr in towns

<b>DOCUMENTATION FOR ENTRY OF FOREIGN REGISTERED VEHICLE</b>	For temporary importation a temporary carnet is required. You require foreign vehicle permit and a third party insurance cover
<b>FUEL</b>	Unleaded fuel is available all over the country.
<b>ACCOMODATION</b>	Contact your travel agent to book for accommodation
<b>HEALTH REQUIREMENTS</b>	Yellow fever inoculation
